## Scandinavia House as an Event Venue

In addition to the cultural and educational programs presented by the ASF, Scandinavia House has become a popular event venue for corporate, nonprofit, and private usage. The variety of spaces in the building include facilities for small and large meetings, conferences, seminars, receptions, dinner, luncheons, concerts, and film screenings.

Among the companies and organizations that have used the spaces at Scandinavia House over the past two years are: the Nordic Consulates, the Nordic-American Chambers of Commerce, the Scandinavian Tourist Boards; a number of UN agencies (including UNICEF, the United Nations Population Fund, and UNFPA); companies such as Burton Snowboard, Citizen's Bank, Corcoran Real Estate, deCode Genetics, Federated Department Stores, Halstead Real Estate, Liz ClaiborneShoes, Lumine Cosmetics, Maytag, Pfizer, Saga Furs of Scandinavia, and Schefflin-Somerset; organizations such as the Author's Guild, Child Development Foundation, Children's World, The Hunger Project, The Latvian Cultural Organization, Rotary Club, Swedish Women's Educational Association; and alumni groups including those from Brown University, Columbia University, and St. Olaf College.

The use of the facilities by outside companies and organizations introduces many of their members and clients to Scandinavia House and its programs, while providing needed support for the operations of the building.

## Scandinavia House's AQ Café

AQ Café, operated by Restaurant Aquavit, is located on the main floor at Scandinavia House in a bright, airy setting, with café tables and colorful chairs designed by Arne Jacobsen. It is a popular lunchtime destination for Scandinavians and Americans alike, featuring a selection of contemporary and traditional Nordic specialties.



## The Shop@Scandinavia House

The Shop@Scandinavia House offers a wide selection of the best of Scandinavian design — both contemporary and classic — in jewelry, accessories, items for the home, furniture and toys. Specialty foods, candy, books, stationery, music, videos, DVDs, and stationery, all with a Nordic flair, are also available.

Each year during the holiday season the Shop@Scandinavia House expands to fill the 3rd floor galleries, adding many gift items and a large selection of Christmas decorations and ornaments. From time to time throughout the year, the Shop also hosts trunk shows, book signings, and "meet the designer" evenings.
