Scandinavian Review, the ASF's primary publication, is an illustrated journal that brings its readers articles on a broad range of topics related to all aspects of life and culture in the Nordic countries: from the performing and visual arts to peacekeeping, scientific advances, and historical subjects. The *Review*, published continuously since 1913, reaches an audience of more than 10,000 Associate members, subscribers, donors, and other readers throughout the United States, Canada and Europe.



Three issues of *Scandinavian Review* were published during each of the two fiscal years of 2004 and 2005. Spring 2005 had a special focus on Norway at 100, in recognition of Norway's centennial of modern independence.

The ASF's quarterly membership newsletter *Scan* reported on ASF activities as well as Nordic events nationwide. Two issues of *The Longboat*, published for those who have been recipients of ASF fellowships and grants, included news of current awards along with information on accomplishments of former fellows.
