WHEN ANY MATTER IN WHICH A MEMBER HAS AN INTEREST COMES BEFORE THE BOARD OR ANY COMMITTEE OR SUB-COMMITTEE OF THE BOARD FOR DECISION OR APPROVAL, THAT INTEREST SHALL BE IMMEDIATELY DISCLOSED TO THE BOARD OR THE COMMITTEE OR SUB-COMMITTEE BY THAT MEMBER, AND THE MEMBER SHALL RECUSE HIMSELF OR HERSELF FROM ANY DISCUSSION AND/OR VOTE RELATING THERETO.
